Symptoms of Depression and Anxiety

If you feel persistently experience at least three of these symptom such as sad, depression, or anxiety most of the time, losing interest or pleasure in most daily activities, for more than two weeks you may experiencing depression:

Feelings may include: irritable mood, which may manifest itself as anger or aggression, sadness, hopelessness, emptiness; feeling overwhelmed, worthlessness, or persistent guilt.

Thoughts can be influenced by: indecision, loss of self-esteem, negative thoughts such as "I'm a failure", "it's my fault" or "life is not worth living", along with excessive worrying about finances challenges occurring within the family and frequent thoughts of death and dying, suicide.

Behavioural symptoms include: general slowing down of thought processes, irritability, neglecting responsibilities including self-care, withdrawing from family and friends, acting in a less than usual manner, decreased ability to function on a daily basis, feeling confused, worried and agitated. Other symptoms include inability to find pleasure in any activity, denying that depressed mood is a defense mechanism.

Physical symptoms include: memory loss, sleeping, interrupted or difunctional sleeping patterns, feeling tired all the time, slowing down in movement, persistent headaches, back or body pain, indigestion, nausea, changes in bowel habits, agitation, pacing around worriedly, appetite, weakness or physical changes such as significant weight loss or gain.

Your worries may not go away on their own, and they may get worse over time if you don't seek help. See your doctor or a mental health provider before your anxiety gets worse. It's easier to treat if you get help early.

Amount of funding for each level of home care services

The Australian Government contributes a different amount for each level of Home Care Package and the contribution changes on 1 July every year; these figures below are up to date as at 1 July 2021. The government subsidy for each package level is as follows:

<u>Package level</u>	Daily government subsidy rate	Daily government subsidy rate
Level 1	\$24.73	\$9,026.45
Level 2	\$43.50	\$15,877.50
Level 3	\$94.66	\$34,550.90
Level 4	\$143.50	\$52,377.50
